Sealed bids for the Burtchville Township Watermain Extension - Harris Road from State Road to M-25 will be received by the Burtchville Township, Michigan, at the office of Burtchville Township, 4000 Burtch Road, Burtchville Township, Michigan, 48059 until 10:00AM, prevailing local time on Tuesday, May 14, 2024. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter for the construction of Burtchville Township Watermain Extension – Harris Road from State Road to M-25.

The work shall consist of furnishing all labor, material, and equipment required to install 5380 lineal feet of 12-inch diameter watermain, fire hydrants, gate wells, water services, drainage culverts, road ditching, lawn restoration, temporary traffic control and other incidental related items.
