RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT AND CONCURRENCE

FOR THE RE ADOPTION OF THE

BURTCHVILLE TOWNSHIP COMPREHENSIVE MASTER PLAN (2000-2020)

Resolution to support and concur with the action of the Burtchville Township Planning Commission to re-adopt the current Comprehensive Master Plan after the five year review and to update the appropriate references within the Appendix.

WHEREAS, the Michigan Planning Enabling Act of 2008 (Act 33) as amended, provides the Burtchville Township Planning Commission with the authority to prepare and adopt a community wide Comprehensive Master Plan and requires that said plan is reviewed and discussed at a regularly scheduled Planning Commission meeting every five years to determine relevancy; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan Planning Enabling Act of 2008 (Act 33) as amended, requires that after the review and discussion, the Planning Commission must decide to either: make no amendments and re-adopt the current Master Plan; make amendments to specific chapters, maps, goals or objectives of the Master Plan; or, to create a new Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Burtchville Township Planning Commission adopted the current Comprehensive Master Plan on February 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, as a result of the review and discussions during regularly scheduled meetings on January 6, 2026 and February 3, 2026, decided to not amend the current plan, including narrative text, goals or objectives with the exception of providing updated references, census data, links and maps within the existing Appendix; and

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2026 the Planning Commission approved a resolution to re-adopt the current comprehensive, Master Plan and incorporate by references in the existing Appendix, the updated links to census data, maps, the current Recreation Plan, Capital Improvement Plan, Placemaking Concepts, and related subplans as feasible; and

WHEREAS, it is the Planning Commission's desire to forward said authorizing resolution to the Burtchville Township Board of Trustees and request for their consideration, a resolution of support and concurrence;
